### What is a ButtKicker<sup>®</sup>?

The ButtKicker is a "silent subwoofer" that allows you to feel powerful bass without excessive volume.

Unlike a subwoofer which can be heard and felt throughout a home, the ButtKicker makes no audible sound and its vibration is contained within the seating. You and your guests will experience realistic special effects and concert quality music without waking the kids or disturbing the neighbors.

The ButtKicker uses the same audio signal that a subwoofer uses. A subwoofer moves air which the listener hears but mainly feels - the ButtKicker simply allows the listener to feel the bass (low end) directly—without the loudness. The ButtKicker can be used with or instead of a subwoofer.

Technically, the ButtKicker is a "low frequency transducer" that has a 3.25 lb piston magnetically suspended inside the motor housing that responds accurately, powerfully and quickly to audio signals. When powered by an amplifier, the ButtKicker produces vibrations that are transferred directly to the seating. With

only one moving part and a thermal protection switch, the ButtKicker has proven itself to be maintenance free and virtually indestructible.

### Connecting to Your Home Theater?

The ButtKicker easily connects to home theater and video game systems. Just like a powered subwoofer, the ButtKicker requires a separate amplifier. One ButtKicker amplifier can power up to four ButtKickers - 4 separate seats. An optional Quick Connection Kit simplifies wiring. An optional RF wireless add-on enables the audio signal to be sent to the ButtKicker amplifier which eliminates the need to run speaker wire from the front of the room to the seating. Installation instructions are included and toll-free technical support is available.
